



Therapeutic Riding – Barn Protocol

The safety and health of our students, families, staff and volunteers are our top priorities. To ensure everyone's safety, please carefully read our new barn protocol.

Arrival:

****We strongly recommend and encourage all participants and families watching to wear a mask and gloves for the duration of the lesson to minimize the spread of the virus.***

1. Parents drop off riders at the deck (left of the barn) with a volunteer
2. Parents can watch either at the deck or at the walking tree
 - a. Parents will no longer have access to the inside of the barn or to sit or stand by the side of the arena to watch (except for the restroom and water fountain).
 - b. Chairs will be set up 6 ft apart at the walking tree for families to sit
3. Volunteer/staff will take riders' temperature
 - a. Riders with a temperature of 100 degrees and higher will not be permitted to ride
4. Rider must wash hands/sanitize
5. Place helmet on
6. Wait for instructions in designated spots (tape on the ground) from volunteer/staff member

Dismissal:

1. Place helmet on the table
2. Thoroughly wash hands
3. Exit through the door and gate on the right side of the barn
